Bonnie Beret




*This simple beret nods to Faye Dunaway's
classic look in Bonnie and Clyde—
updated here in a chunky yarn.*



finished measurements

- ◆ Diameter 11"/28cm

materials and tools

- ◆ Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick and Quick (80% wool, 20% acrylic; 6oz/170g = 108yd/98m): 1 skein, color butterscotch #189—approx 108yd/98m of super bulky weight yarn 
- ◆ Crochet hook: 11.50mm (size P-15 U.S.) or size to obtain gauge
- ◆ Yarn needle

gauge

- ◆ 7 dc and 4 rows = 4"/10cm

Always take time to check your gauge.

stitches used

- ◆ chain (ch)
- ◆ slip stitch (sl st)
- ◆ double crochet (dc)
- ◆ single crochet (sc)
- ◆ double crochet two stitches together (dc2tog)

Note: Optional color shown is lemongrass #132.



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instructions

Ch 3, join with a sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 14 dc into ring, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2-15 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, dc in same st as beg ch, work 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2-30 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 2, dc, work 2 dc in next st, *dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2-40 dc.

Rnds 4-5: Ch 2, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2-40 dc.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, dc, dc2tog (counts as 1 dc), *dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog; rep from * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2-30 dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 2, dc in each st around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-2-30 dc.

Rnds 8-9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to beg ch-1.

Fasten off.

Finishing

Using yarn needle, weave in ends.
